Items accepted include:

## Glass Containers

Any color food & beverage containers, clear, green or brown  
Remove all caps, lids & plastic  
Paper labels are acceptable

## Tin Cans

Steel food and beverage, cookie tins, steel screw caps and lids

## Deposit Containers

Plastic, Aluminum, Glass  
Must have deposit label intact

## Aluminum Foil

TV dinner trays, pastry trays and foil items  
Remove any plastic

## Aluminum Cans

Remove any plastic

## Plastic Containers

1 PET  
2 HDPE  
Remove caps, lids, sprayers, metal handles & rings

All items must be clean, dry & loose-not bundled/tied

Remove plastic

## Newspapers/Inserts

## Office Paper

White & colored

## Cardboard

Corrugated boxes, brown paper bags, brown kraft paper, pizza boxes

## Boxboard/Chipboard

Cereal, pasta, detergent, baking mix, brown envelopes etc.

All items must be empty of fluids, food & debris
